Under the theme “Diversity of Knowledge for a Sustainable Future in Latin America”, SETAC LA 2021 presentations can be published in a special issue of the SETAC journal *IEAM (Integrated Environmental Assessment and Management)*!

The special issue of *IEAM* will highlight work presented at SETAC LA 2021. Interested presenters are asked to first prepare an extended abstract for evaluation by the Guest Editors of the special issue.

Be aware of:

- The Guest Editors will select from extended abstracts (instructions below) the ones that are suitable for submission to the special issue. The decision to accept a paper for the inclusion in the special issue will be made based on thematic fit with *IEAM* scope and scientific quality.
- Papers to be submitted to *IEAM* must have been previously presented in the SETAC LA 2021 (Valdivia, Chile) sessions.
- Papers to be submitted to *IEAM* must demonstrate an application of the science or research to environmental decision making and/or problem solving following the aim and scope of the journal:

All special issue papers will go through *IEAM*'s standard, double-blind peer-review process.

Extended Abstract Guidelines

- Title should be no longer than 200 characters, while the abstract is limited to 300 words (no figures and/or tables are allowed).
- Abstract should be clearly written in English and structured as follows: introduction with hypothesis/objectives, research question, methodology, results, and interpretation.
- Abstract must NOT promote a commercial product, process, or service.
- Authors should comply with instructions and deadlines.
